

Oglethorpe Power Corporation (An Electric Membership Corporation) (OPC), co-licensee for the existing Rocky Mountain Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 2725 (Rocky Mountain Project, Project), hereby notifies the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC, Commission) on behalf of itself and co-licensees Georgia Power Company, Rocky Mountain Leasing Corporation, and U.S. Bank National Association of its intent to relicense the Project. Along with this cover letter, this filing consists of the following components:

- 1. Notification of Intent (NOI), including a request to use the Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) (Public)
- 2. Pre-Application Document (PAD) (Public)

OPC requests to use the TLP in accordance with the Commission's regulations at 18 CFR § 16.8. The NOI includes OPC's detailed justification for requesting to use the TLP pursuant to 18 CFR § 5.3(c)(1)(ii). OPC believes using the TLP will be in the best interest of the Commission and all participants based on its flexible timeframes, a low likelihood for complex resource issues or controversy at the Rocky Mountain Project, lower relative
